Subject:- Policy Guidelines for considering Officers for various UN Assignments :- allowances/license fee regarding

The undersigned is directed to refer to this ministry's letter No. 21023/30/2012 dated 27.02.2013 through which policy guidelines issued for considering officers for various UN Assignments and clarified that :-

(i) Payment of other allowances along with salary by parent organization in respect of the personnel deployed for UN Missions will be governed as per Para- 3.3(Entitlement during deployment) of MHA's policy issued vide ibid letter that is " the officers, on their deployment in the mission, will get subsistence allowance from UN while on such deployment. They will be entitled to draw their salary and other allowances from their parent organization/States concerned. They may also be allowed to retain Government accommodation, telephone etc, if any, during the tenure of such deployment for their families.

(ii) Officers are allowed to retain Government accommodation, telephone etc if any, on payment of normal license fee/rate during the approved tenure of deployment to the UN Missions for their families.
