A large number of officers working with the Central Bureau of investigation are deputed from other government organizations. This helps create a dynamic learning and working environment, with individuals bringing in the skills and expertise they have gained in their previous roles/across other services. The experience gained by them in CBI would benefit the parent organizations as well.

The Bureau currently has 19 and 35 vacancies in the rank of Deputy Inspector General of Police and Superintendent of Police respectively. These are to be filled up by deputation as per the IPS Tenure Policy. Efforts made by us to fill these positions have been futile owing to the non-receipt of cadre clearances from the State Governments.

I would be grateful, if necessary instructions can be issued to the concerned officers in your State to recommend names of suitable and willing IPS officers who can be relieved immediately to help fill the aforementioned positions on an immediate basis.
