CIRCULAR

All Secretaries and Heads of Department of Government of Sikkim may kindly recall the instructions given by the Chief Secretary in more than one meeting / conference as regards the following:-

1. Officers and employees cannot submit joint representation in regard to their grievances as it will mean contravention of relevant section/rule of the Conduct Rules of State Government.
2. In the same way they are not supposed to bring in political pressure for their grievances under any circumstance. This is also in tune with relevant provisions Rule 21 of State Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1981 as also that of Govt. of India.

In view of the fact that every now and then the above provisions are being violated, all Secretaries may issue instructions. A compliance report may be submitted within a week. Further, it is to reiterate that no tour shall be undertaken outside the State without express approval of the Chief Secretary. On return, a detailed tour report as per rules may be submitted.

As usual, punctuality and attendance during the working hours shall have to be maintained and members of public should be heard patiently and their grievances may be followed up in all earnest.
